We do not think that an academic discussion on "... when it is right to deploy that (military) capability ..." will result in specific useful conclusions but that this "deploying" has to be investigated on a case by case basis and that the European Union should give itself collectively the instruments to allow for such a timely investigation.

Also a "transfer of responsibility" may be seen by some as resulting in a reduction of "national effectiveness" but not a reduction of "collective effectiveness"; "transfer of responsibility" is aiming at a greater efficiency in a European framework.

And finally: Europe will never be a leader in NATO if it doesn't manage to put its own act together ... together.
