Practical Issues:

How to get to the meeting venue DAP?

From the Airport to DAP: Taxi or public transport


- **TAXI**: Ask for address Vítězné náměstí 4, some taxi drivers would know DAP (abbreviation for "Dům armády Praha") or simply military hotel at Dejvická).
- BUS number 119 from the Airport to the Nádraží Veleslavín station where you change for metro line A "green" and ride to the Dejvická station (direction Depo Hostivař). The trip should take about 30 minutes therefore at the airport you should buy tickets (from the machine) for 24 CZK (1 €) which are valid for 30 minutes. Tickets should be stamped when boarding the bus. When you change from bus to metro you need not to stamp the ticket again. There is only one ticket for all the public means inside Prague (BUS, Tram and Metro).

Finding DAP at the *Dejvická* **station**: There are two exits from the metro platform. One with escalators and the other with only stairs. The exit with stairs is ideal to reach DAP. Walk up the stairs and then go through a corridor to the right followed by stairs to the surface level. You have reached the main square and on your right-hand side you should see DAP (the building on the left side of the picture, on the right you can see the metro exit).



How to get to the Conference venue on Friday?

- **TRAM:** From Station Vítězné náměstí (DAP is 50 metres from the stop station is to the left of the DAP building as seen at the picture) to station Malostranské náměstí with **tram number 20** (goes á 10 minutes and is about 10 minutes travel time). Profesní dům venue is 30 meters from the stop up the hill (see picture the entrance in the middle).
- TAXI: Ask for "Profesní dům", address Malostranské náměstí 25.



How to get to Ministry of Foreign Affairs (MFA) on Friday?

There will be Mr. Jakub Kufčák and Mr. Dušan Švarc, who will have public transport tickets for you and will take you to the MFA and then back to the *Dejvická station* (or you can go to other stations where your hotels are). We have to be at the MFA on time, therefore we have to leave the conference before 15:00. We have to follow Mr. Kufčák otherwise some could get lost (It happened to us in Paris).

Partner program on Friday

Meeting point: In front of the hotel DAP (Vítězné náměstí 4) at 9:00. Transport by Metro and Tram to Prague Castle (tickets there and back will be prepared for you by Ms. Stejskalová)
