1.- Approval of the list of decisions of the Prague Council

The List of decisions -dated 10 11 2018- of the Presidents' Council of 17/19 October 2018 in Brussels is approved.

2.1.- National associations.

2.1.1.- EuroDéfense-Italia

Professor Fabrizio W Luciolli confirm that EuroDefense-Italia is now organized and the board completed.

President Theodossis Georgiu had apologized for not being able to participate at this Council.

2.1.3.- EuroDéfense-Luxembourg

Unfortunately, EuroDéfense-Luxembourg had not answered any attempts at making contact.

2.2.- Extension of the network.

2.2.1.- Estonia

Robin Ashby is in contact with the Estonian defense attaché who spoke to a former Estonian Chief of Defence. Nothing new.

2.2.2.- Latvia

Contact with the Latvian defence attaché in Great Britain. Nothing new.

2.2.3.- Finland

The contacts through WEU parliamentarian Assembly former members is going on with a ED-France president mission in Finland.

2.2.4.-Poland

Still good contact with senator Bodgan Klich

2.3.- Brexit consequences on ED-UK

ED-UK will continue as a member of EURODEFENSE at least during the transition period for Brexit and was therefore expected to attend the international conference in Romania in 2019. Membership after the transition period would be influenced by the closeness of the future defence and security relationship between the EU and the UK, yet to be determined.

It has been noted that the EURODEFENSE chart does not says that the members have to be in the EU but in Europe.

EuroDéfense-Romania confirm its invitation for the autumn 2019 IME from 3 to 5 October.

4.1.3.- EWG 17 (ED-UK) "Cyber security"

A EuroDefense-UK document has been circulating among the EWG members. We wait a report for the Bucharest meeting.

4.1.4.- EWG22 (ED-Deutschland) Migrants and refugees

EuroDefense-Deutschland circulate a document among the EWG with proposals in the migration's security domain.

.4.2.- EURODEFENSE Working Groups (EWGs)

4.2.1.- EWG 18 (ED-France) – EDEM – EDTIB

. EWG18 is closed, but EuroDéfense-France keep in contact with some Commission members to keep an eye on the sitution evolution.

4.2.2.-EWG27

It has been decided to establish an EWG 27 on the item of the Nederland document" EU security is EU responsibility". The situation analysis has been appreciated by the majority of members, but it has been requested to enlarge the mandate for studying several solutions for the EU future organization in the defense domain.

4.2.3.- EWG28 Hybrid warfare.

It has been decided to establish an EWG 28 on the item "Hybrid warfare" based on the document of ED-Deustchland which have to propose a mandate.

5.- Parnership agreement with ESDA

A partnership agreement has been signed with ESDA (European Security and Defence Association). This association group European members of parliaments interested in defense matters and is at present chaired by Robert Walter, former WEU Assembly president. (Annex 5)

6.- Associations activities

ED-Espana: The 7th November 2018 ED-ES organized and carried out the 1st informative session on the CSD of the EU in the CEOE on 19th February 2019 ED-ES had a working meeting in Lisbon with members of ED-Portugal. The 10th April the Vice President of ED -ES attended in Lisbon the very informative conference organized by ED-Portugal. The Spring Presidents Council in Madrid preparation was, of course, a major endeavor in 2019 for EURODEFENSE-ESPANA.

ED-France: Preparation of a conference in Senate house:" Europe 30 years after the Berlin wall fall" for the 8 November 2019 and a conference in Strasbourg in March 2020.

ED-Nederland: Agreement with the "European Movement": ED-NL is a commission of this movement; this balance the NATO commission. Article in the NATO review and contact with the Parliament.

ED-Deutschland: Good contact with the MOD.

ED-Romania: Contact with authorities to prepare autumn 2019 IME. Studies on Blockchain and Black Sea. Large international Conference on Critical Infrastructures Protection.

ED-Italia: Bureau finalizing. Wish to interest youngs: Youngs European EURODEFENSE Conference. preparation for 2020.

ED-Austria: European neighborhoods colloquy. African and North Africa situations analysis. Asiatic think tanks cooperation.

ED-Portugal: Good links with industry: conference with industries involved in PESCO, EU authority's presence. Close contacts with ED-Espana.

ED-UK: Contact with MOD, study of Brexit consequences. Looking for youngs.

ED-Magyarorszàg; Contact with industry. Interest for PESCO and Cyber defence.

ED-Belgium. Creation of a young's section with the Atlantic Association. Study on Black Sea Russian action.
